### INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger Transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by observation on Polaris. The distances were measured with a 100-ft. and 500-ft. steel tapes.

### REPORT.

The lode line of each location of this claim was run directly upon the ground, and the several corners establ-shed by means of offsets from the lode lines. All tie lines were run either directly upon the ground or by traverses, run upon the ground and submitted in a separate report herewith.

Note - Owining to the position of tunnel No.3, Senator lode, and of its being located upon ground that is from
