I determined the true meridian by an observation on Polaris at its eastern elongation on May 6, 1913 at approximately 4:50 a.m., Mountain Time, using 1°22'30" as the azimuth of the star.

MAGNETIC VARIATION.

The magnetic variation is 13050 E. at all corners.

DISCREPANCIES.

The discrepancies between this survey and the adjoining surveys are due to errors in the latter.
