INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Surley Solar Transit. The courses were deflected from the meridian as determined by direct Solar observations. The distances were measured with 100-ft. and 500-ft. steel tapes.

The tie line and lode line of this claim were run upon the ground, and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line.

U.S.M.M. No. 3.T.C. is U.S.M.M. No. 3.T.C. chiseled on granite rock in place 5X2 ft. above the ground with mound of stones, 5 ft. base X 4 ft. high, situated on a ridge on the Sookum lode sur. No. 913.
