INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Gurley Solar Transit. The courses were deflected from the meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 100-ft. and 500-ft. steel tapes.

From the common improvement shaft No. 3 on the Swindler lode the surface ascends to the S.E. and descends to N.W. this shaft is so located that the Huron No. One and the Huron No. 2 lodes may be developed by drifting from this shaft. The Brushy Flat, Eagle Fraction and Montezuma lodes are lower than this shaft so cannot receive benefit from it.

The standard cor to secs 32&33 T. 13 N. R. 1 E. is a 3 inch pipe properly marked

Cors. 1 & 4 Princes Placer are small mounds of stones.

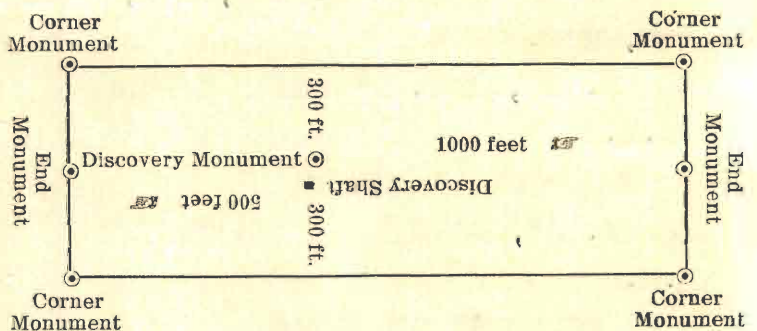

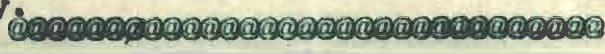
