INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a C.L. Berger mining transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT

The lode lines were run directly upon the ground, and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode lines.

All tie lines were run directly upon the ground, or by traverses run upon the ground, and submitted in a separate report.

The W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. of Sec. 8, unapproved T.19N. R.20 W., G.& S. R. B. & M., is a 1 in. iron pipe, with a brass cap, properly set and marked.

U.S.L.M. No. 2670 is an andesite rock in a mound of rock 5 ft. high, 4 ft. base, chiseled U.S.L.M.2670.

All the corners of the Times and Times No. 2 lodes are 4 inch pine posts, properly set and scribed. Sur. No. 3262, Ivanhoe Fraction lode.

All the corners are 4 inch pine posts, properly set and marked.
