## INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger & Son's transit. The courseswere deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a steel tape.

## REPORT

The lines of this claim and connections to adjoining and conflicting claims, were run direct upon the ground. U.S.I.M. No. 1602 is a basalt stone 8 x 15 x 14 ins. above the ground, chiseled with a cross (X) and U.S.I.M. 1602.

The common corner to Secs. 21-22-27-28,T. 19N.,R. 20 W., unapproved, G.& S.R. B. & M., is a 2 in. iron pipe, properly set and marked.

The 1/4 Corner between Secs. 27 and 28, township and range aforesaid, is a 1 in. iron pipe, properly set and marked.


