Improvement wo.1 Shamrock lode was sunk originally to develop the fourteen lodes owned by the company prior to 1916. I have included in my estimate "Machinery and mining equipment" as "Common Improvement" due to the fact that said machinery and equipment, as herein mentioned are actually associated with the excavation, in the main working shaft, and are essential to the practical development of and actually facilitate the extraction of mineral from the claim.

The development work is being done on the 1100 and 1650 foot levels, and the two hoisting plants, steam and electric are used in the necessary mining operations to carry on said development work. The steam plant was originally used for all power necessary to operate the mine, and the electric plant has been lately installed to reduce operation costs, thus making the steam plant an emergency unit.

The pumps installed on the different levels, and stations are used to take care of the heavy flow of water encountered in the development of the mine.

The compressors are used in the operation of air drills, to facilitate the extraction of mineral and development work.

The buildings mentioned, shelter the different units and are necessary for the proper care of above mentioned equipment. The blacksmith and machine shop are necessary for the proper care and operation of the above mentioned equipment, and the sharpening of the tools used in the actual excavation of tunnels etc.

The discrepancies found existing between the lodes as marked by location monuments and as described in the location notices are due to errors in the location notices.

The discrepancies between the lines of this survey and prior approved surveys are due to errors in the latter.


