

Excerpts from the Mining Laws of

This diagram is to give locator a general idea of plan of location under the new law. The Discovery Shaft can be in the center of claim or any distance from either end desired. In the diagram it is placed 500 feet from the other. Commence description of claim at a center end monument, giving its distance and direction from center of Discovery Shaft; thence bound the claim in either direction. In description be careful to state locality of claim with reference to some natural object, or permanent monument, as will identify the claim.

2. To sink a discovery shaft in above the surface of the ground, or least three feet high, to-wit: One at Sec. 8. Location notices may be the point of discovery a conspicuous three feet in height, or an upright least four feet above the ground, in cation notice which shall be signed ninety days within which to do or cause to be done the following things: the claim to a depth of at least eight feet from the lowest part of the rim Sec. 6. Such surface boundaries shall be marked by six substantial posts projecting at least four feet each corner of said claim and one at the amended location; Provided, That Title XLVII of the Revised Statutes Sec. 2. Such location shall be made by erecting at or contiguous to monument of stones not less than post, securely fixed, projecting at which monument of stones or on which post there shall be posted a loby the name or names of the locator Sec. 4.
