This Mining Claim, the name of which is the "Rex Fraction" Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purposes of exploration and purchase by the United Verde Copper Company, a corporation existing under the laws of the State of Delaware the undersigned, on the 29th day of January, 1918

The length of this claim is 700 feet, and we claim 600 feet in a westerly direction and 100 feet in a easterly direction from the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim.
