REPORT.

The ties were made to USLM 2499 a large block of limestone with "USLM 2499" chiseled thereon, the point of sight being a cross on the sloping top of the block $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches south of the letter "4" in the number 2499; a large mound of stones is erected on the north side of the block. Corner No 3, Diamond H No 1, Survey No 3248, a pine post 4x4 inches bears S.46°45'W. 291 ft; this Mineral Monument was used as I could find no Section Corner or $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner within two miles of any of the lode claims of this survey; the west $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 19, T1N, R15E. was located under the track scales of the Inspiration Consolidated Copper Co Railroad and marked by E. T. Stewart U. S. Mineral Surveyor on top of the scale platform; these scales have been removed and the pit filled up and no sign of their former position is found. U. S. L. M. No 9, established in 1885 by C. H. Wallace, U.S. Deputy Min Surveyor cannot be found or the point identified. Survey No 3248, Warrior Copper Co Claimant, Corners 1, 3 & 4 are pine posts 4x4 inches, properly set and scribed; Corner No 2 was lying on the ground but I reset it in its proper place by means of the Dacite bearing stone N48°33'E 22.85 ft.

Gila Monster lode, unsurveyed Ralston Mining Co Claimant, the North east, Northwest and Southeast corners are 4x4 pine posts marked "Gila Monster"; there is no exclusion from the Two Million lode this survey of the Gila Monster lode unsurveyed.

White Horse lode, unsurveyed, Ralston Mining Co Claimant the Northeast and Northwest Corners are 4x4 inch pine posts and marked White Horse.

An amended survey was made of the claims of this survey in 1906, but through some oversight the amended certificates were not recorded until February 1918; this accounts for the absence of some of the corner stakes; they were reset however within the lines of the amended locations in every case; as I made the amended survey, and one of my assistants in that survey was with me in this official survey, I was able to retrace the old lines with certainty.
