ADJOINING CLAIMS

This claim is bounded on the north by Chas. Davis, Guarantee, and Gold Standard lodes of survey 3683. On the east, south, and west by U.S. Land.

INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a light mountain Gurley transit. The courses were deflected from the meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 500 ft. and a 50 ft steel tape.

REPORT

The lode line of each location of this claim was run directly upon the ground, and the several corners were established by means of offsets therefrom. All tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The S.E. Cor. section ten T 13 N, R1 E is a granite stone 9x8x14 ins above the ground in a mound of stones, chiselled 4 notches on the south side and 2 on the east.

As the S.E Cor. section 10 T 13 N, R 1 E was the
nearest cor. of the public ^{land} survey that could be found
the ties were made to this cor. The corners and $\frac{1}{2}$ Cors.
that determine the lines of the public survey that
intersect the lines of this claim could not be found so
the official notes were used in figuring the intersections.
