In executing this survey, I inadvertently marked the northeast corner of the Muscal lode as cor.No.1. The greater southing of the course of its end line as compared with the other two lodes of this survey caused this error. I did not know that Cor.No.4 was closer to the

U.S.M.No.2 until making my calculations after return from the field.

The discrepancies found existing between the claims as marekd by the location monuments and as described in the location notices are due to errors in the location notices.

The discrepancies between the lines of this survey and prior approved surveys are due to errors in the latter.
