At the time of this survey I found the stone again firmly set in the ground but not in the exact spot where it had lain fourteen months previous. However there was no certainty that the stone while down was ly-

ing at exactly the correct point. The line between this corner as last found and the $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. bet. Secs. 31 & 36, and the line bet. this Cor. and $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. bet. Secs. 25 & 30 were carefully run by me. They did not agree with the recorded notes nor could they be made to. Hence I concluded it best to accept this section corner as I found it.
