I certify that the value of labor and improvements
made upon and for the benefit of this claim, by the

INSTRUMENT and MERIDIAN.

This survey was made with a Berger & Sons transit

and a 500 ft. steel tape.

The Meridian was determined by direct observation on the sun.

Report

All side and end lines and all other lines were run direct on the ground.

Cor. No. 3 Juror No. 2 lode, Sur. No. 3600 is a stone properly set and marked.

Section lines and corners;

Beginning at the 1/4 corner of sections 7 & 8, which is a stone, properly marked, I go N. 0° 12' W. 2736 ft. to a mound of earth and stone with the remains of an old post in the center. The upper part of this post had been removed to location monument. I set this post in its original position as the corner of sections 5-6-7-8, T. 22 N. R. 17 W.

The 1/4 corners to the west, north and east, were not in evidence and the north and east ties are given as per Public Land Survey records.

The section corner of 6 & 7 is a stone, properly set and marked and being the most permanent I tie corner No. 1 of this survey to it.

Ties to the corner of sections 5-6-7-8, Juror No. 2 lode, Sur. No. 3600 are in error due to wrong location of section corner.

Adjoining & Conflicting claims

This survey conflicts with the Mohawk No. 2 lode, unsurveyed, on the westerly end, Claimant unknown.

All other sides are joined by public domain.
