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#### ADJOINING AND CONFLICTING CLAIMS.

This survey is bounded on the north by Sur. 3788, <del>inapproved</del>; owned by B.H. Kerrick, et al; and by unappropriated Indian Reservation. On the east by unknown claims unsurveyed, owners unknown, On the south and west by unappropriated Indian Reservation. Feet.

INSTRUMENT AND DETERMINATION OF MERIDIAN.

This survey was made with a  $6\frac{1}{4}$  inch Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by Poraris abservation, verified by Solar observation.

The distances were measured with a 660 foot steel tape.

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REPORT.

U.S.L.M. No. 3788, to which tie is given, is a diabase boulder, 12 x 16 x 18 ins. above the ground, chiseled cross at the exact point and U.S.L.M. 3788, with mound of stone alongside. The tie to this monument was made direct from Cor. No. 1.

No. 2 is set limestone, both corners being properly marked, with mound of stone alongside. The bearing of line 1-2 was determined direct and the extent of the conflict with said survey 3788 and the tie from Cor. No. 8 of this Sur. to Cor. No. 1 of said Sur. 3788, was computed through a traverse run N.55°-56'H. 203.8 ft.; thence N.33°-10'H 1928.2 ft. from Cor. No. 8 of this survey to Cor. No. 1 of said Survey 3788.
