The lines of this survey and connections to Sec.Cor. and conflicting claims were run upon the ground and found to be as herein given.

The N. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor.Sec. 35 T.16 N.R.2 E. G.& S.R.B.& M. is a 1 in.iron pipe with bronze cap properly set and marked.

Cor.No.3 Sur.No.1421 Mountain View lode having been destroyed,its position was determined by course and distance from bearing rocks as given in the field notes of said Sur.No.1421, the bearing rocks being found in place.

The remaining corners of conflicting and adjoining surveyed claims are stones, found in place properly set and marked.

The original corners of the Lucky Bill location and of the adjoining Fraction lode are 4 x 4 in.posts set in mounds of rock.

Note

The discrepancy between these field notes and the location certificate with respect to the courses and lengths of boundary lines is due to inaccuracies in the latter.


