Instrument.

This survey was made with a C.L. Berger & Sons transit The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with steel tapes.

Report.

The lines of this survey and connections to Sec. Cor. and conflicting and adjoining claims were run upon the ground.

The S.W. Cor. Sec. 23 T. 16 N. R. 2 E. is an iron pipe with bronze cap properly marked.

Cor. No. 1 Fishers Corner lode is the original stone in place, properly chiseled. All other corners of Sur. No. 1151 and 1284 are concrete monuments as described.

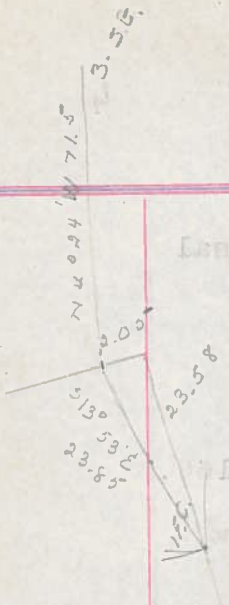
Cor. No. 2 Sur. No. 3239 Granny lode-The original stone

corner chiseled 13,1-1284 G,2-3239 was found along side the concrete monument which replaced it.

Cor.No.5 Sur.No.3239 Granny lode and the W.C.thereto are covered by the tunnel dump. Its position was determined from the official tie to Cor.No.1 Fishers Corner checked by the common bearing rock,as recorded in the returns of Sur.3239. Cor.No.4 said Granny lode is a concrete monument. The corner monuments of the location of this claim were found to be concrete monuments as described herein with monuments of rock alongside and unpainted 4 x 4 in. posts 3 1/2 ft.long.

Note

It appears that the original notice of location describes a claim of maximum size to wit,600 x 1500 ft. Whereas said claim was monumented only 100 x 785.70 ft. as shown in these notes. The notice is therefore inaccurate in description of exterior boundaries.
