## Instrument

This survey was made with a C.L. Berger & Sons, transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as

determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with steel tapes.

#### Report

The lines of this survey and connections to W.C. to Sec. Cor. and conflicting claims were run upon the ground.

The W.C. to the S.W. Cor. Sec. 26 T.16 N.R.2 E. G. & S.R. B. & M. is a 2 in. iron pipe with bronze cap marked W.C.

and the correct corner designation. Said W.C. is  $S.0^{\circ}1'E.$  20 lks. from the true corner point.

The corners of the conflicting claims are stone corners

found in place and properly marked excepting only Cor.

No. 4 Sur. No. 1592 Black Horse lode. Said corner having been removed in making a trail, was relocated by me from the official bearing rock tie.

#### Note

The discrepancy between these notes and the amended location notice in the length of the end lines is due to inaccuracies in the latter.
