- A. The soil is gravel covered with a thin layer of sand and loam; some schist rock on the extreme southern end.

  Practically no growth with the exception of scattering oak brush, and three or four ash trees.
- B. Big Bug Creek flows in an easterly direction through the claim; approximate fall 3 ft. per hundred.
- The workings upon the claim consist of :
  No. 1 A shaft 5'x5'x25' which bears S60°E 531.0' from

  - No. 2 A shaft 5 ft. in diameter, 22 ft. deep, which bears S50°50'E 220' from Cor. No. 1.

- D. This claim is located just east of the town of Mayer.
