Instrument

This survey was made with a C.L.Berger & Sons.transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with steel tapes.

Report.

The lines of this survey and ties to conflicting claims were run upon the ground. The connection with the S.W. Cor.Sec.23 T.16 N.R.2 E. as given herein was calculated through Sur.No.4007 Wite Hope lode as shown on accompanying traverse. The said Sec.Cor.is a 1 in.pipe with bronze cap, properly lettered.

Sir.No.595 Wade Hampton and Sleeping Beauty M.S.- The corners of this survey were re-established and marked with concrete monuments several years ago by the engineers of the United Verde Copper Co.

Evidence on the ground corroborates their re-establishment of Cors.Nos.1, 3 and 4 I am unable to find any corroborative evidence of the present position of Cor.No.2 and do not know how it was determined, but am assuming it is correct as I can find no evidence to the contrary.

Sur.No.1271 Red Jacket lode,- Corners have been replaced by concrete monuments, apparently in their original position. The same is true on Sur.No.1351 Lucky Boy South Extension lode.

Sur.No.1615-
Cor.No.1 Gold Hill lode identical with Cor.No.4 Black lode. is the original stone corner, properly marked.

Cor.No.4 Gold Hill, identical with Cor.No.1 Sur.No.1271 Red Jacket and Cor.No.1 Sur.No.3075 Jumbo lodes-is replaced by a concrete monument.

Cor.No.1 Black, identical with Cor.No.4 Blue Bird and Cor.No.3 Last Change lodes- The original stone has been destroyed, but approximate position indicated by remains of rock base. It was replaced as indicated in these notes.

Cors.Nos.1,2 and 4 Last Change lode are original stones in place properly marked. Cor.No.5 Last Change lode has been destroyed, Its position was assumed as on line 2-3 Sur.No.1351 Lucky Boy South Extension lode, at $N.81^{\circ}05'W.$ from Cor.No.1 said Last Change lode.

Sullivan lode- All corners are original stones in place properly marked.

Sur.No.2463

Tiger lode- Cors.Nos.1 and 6 are the original stones in place. Cor.No.4 ^{and Cor.No.5} have been destroyed by road excavation, for the purpose of this survey I have assumed ^{of Cor.No.5} the position, at $N.19^{\circ}E.$ from Cor.No.3 and $S.47^{\circ}04'W.$ -from Cor.No.1

Tiger No.2 lode, both of said corners being the original marked stones in place and the courses of lines of said Sur.No.2463 being generally more accurate than the recorded lengths.

The original notes of said Sur.No.2463 state that Cor.No.2 Tiger No.2 lode was by calculation made identical with Cor.No.2 Sur.No.593 Wade Hampton and Sleeping Beauty M.S. said calculation must have been in error as from present evidence there could have been no actual identity of said corners.

Cor.No.4 Tiger No.2 lode is the original marked stone in place. Cor.No.5 said lode has been destroyed, its position was assumed as on line 2-3 Sur.No.1351 Lucky Boy South Extension lode and at $N.19^{\circ}E.$ - from Cor.No.4 Tiger No.2 lode.

Tiger No.3 lode, All corners not heretofore described are original marked stones in place.

Sur.No.3474 Sunset lode, - All corners are concrete monuments, 12 in. above ground, iron pipe in center.

The stone set for Cor.No.4 Sans Gene No.1 lode was the largest which could be found that was suitable for marking.
