This survey was made with a Keuffel and Esser mountain transit, No. 27089. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct observations upon the sun. The distances were measured with a 300-ft. steel tape.

#### REPORT

The lode line of the Bank Vault lode was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of offsets therefrom. The corners of the Bohemian Girl and Minnehaha lodes were established by means of offsets from traverse lines run as closely as possible to the lode lines.

The disagreements between these field notes and the amended location certificates, -in regard to the lengths and courses of the boundary lines, -are due to errors in the certificates.
