LOCATION.

This claim is located in the Quartz Mountain Mining District, Yavapai County, Arizona, in Secs. 9 and 16, T 13 N, R 2 W, that part in Sec. 9 being within the Prescott National Forest.

INSTRUMENT.

This Sur. was made with a Lietz Transit; the courses were deflected from the Meridian as determined by direct Solar observations. The distances were measured with a 350 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

The Lode lines of these claims were run direct upon the ground and the several corners were established by offsets therefrom. The tie lines were run direct upon the ground. The  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. bet. secs. 9 and 16, T 13 N, R 2W is a mound of stones. Cor. No. 1 Fraction Lode is a granite stone 8" X 12" X 12" above ground chiseled X-F-1-4072. Cor. No. 1 Grove lode Sur. No. 4099 is a granite stone 8" X 10" X 12" above the ground chiseled X-G-1-4099. Cor. No. 4 Grove Lode Sur. No. 4099 is a granite stone 7" X 7" X 12" above ground chiseled X-G-4-4099.

After a diligent search I found only the S.E. Cor and the S $\frac{1}{4}$ <sup>Cor.</sup> of Sec. 9, T 13 N, R 2 W. As these corners were not sufficient for a proper subdivision of this section, I used Mr. J. Wm. Waara's subdivision as given in Sur. No. 4072, Fraction Lode.
