Descriptive Report

Valley Stone Placer

(a) The northern quarter of this claim surface is composed of rolling ridges of detritus, while the southern three quarters of the claim surface is composed of rough hill-sides of rock in place, of igneous nature, in which occurs a quite large deposit of marble and limestone, covered in places with deposits of rocky soil composed of the adjacent rocks.
