Mineral Survey No. 4145 was made with a W & E. E. Gurley Light Mountain transit, with horizontal limb 6.25 inches Light Mountain transit, with horizontal limb 6.25 inches diameter, having two double opposite verniers, and full vertical circle 4.5 inches diameter, having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of arc; the eye p piece is equipped with a colored glass shade for making direct observations on the sun. The instrument was in good condition at the time of survey and all adjustments were in good order. Am a. m. altitude observation of the sun was made at the point of beginning as shown by calculations sheet herewith. The latitude was taken from the official plat of T 17.5, R 23 E, G & S R B & M. All azimuths in this record were referred to the true meridian thus determined, by the method of deflection angles and thus determined, by the method of deflection angles and calculated courses.

The lines were measured with a 333 foot steel tape, graduated to feet, tenths and hundredths of feet for entire length tire length.

All line and connections of this survey were run by direct methods.

The magnetic variation observed at each corner of the the survey gave a uniform value of 13° 40' East. t., with like meridian.

REPORT.

- (a) This placer is situated in the mountainous region on the north end of the Dragoon Mountains. The soil is decomposed limestone and granite and is full of rocks and boulders. Over a large area of the claim there is no soil, the bed rock coming to the surface. The vegetation is sparse, consisting of schrubs and an occasional live oak. There are a very few pines, all of small size.
- (b) There are no streams on this claim. A wash that has water in it at flood times runs through the claim from north to south as shown on the map. The roads and trail on the claim are shown on the map and are private roads having been made by the claimant or his grantors.
- (c) The surface workings consisting of an open cut and two strippings are: open cut 15 x 15 x 52 feet long bears from Cor. No. 2 S 40 31' w 382.0 ft.; a stripping 50 ft wide and 80 ft. long bears from Gor. No. 2 Soo' N'W 450 ft.; a second stripping 10 ft. wide 135 ft. long bears from Cor. No. 2 Soo' N'W 1062 ft.
- (d) The main line of the Southern Pacific Railroad is North 2 1/2 miles from the claim. The county highway from Benson to Willcox, one of the main transcontinental autoroutes lies 2 miles north of the claim. The town of Dragoon, consisting of a few stores and garages and station on the Southern Pacific Railroad, lies 3 1/2 miles north and west.
- (e) The nearest known individual lodes are about 2 1/2 miles to the southeast.
- (f) There is a fine grade of marble on this placer. Carries can be opened up and the marble shipped to the railroad without excess cost. There is no water on the claim but this is no drawback to the successful mining of the marble.
- (g) The works for the development of the claim are as given under (c), with the addition of the road work.
- (h) There are no lode locations, salt licks, salt springs or mill sites on this placer to my knowledge.
