Mineral Survey No. 4148 was made with a C. L. Berger & Sons Precise Transit No. 4634, model No. 1 C, with horizontal limb 6.25 ins. diam., having two double opposite verniers, and full vertical circle 5 ins. diam., having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of arc; the eyepiece is equipped with a colored glass shade set in the dust shutter for making direct observations upon the sun. The instrument was in good condition at the time of survey and all adjustments were in good order. An a. m. altitude observation of the sun for time
and azimuth, and at noon on the meridian for latitude
were made at the point of beginning, the details of which observations are shown in the claculation sheets herewith submitted for examination. All azimuths in this record are referred to the true meridian thus determined, by the method of deflection angles and calculated courses. bento
