Feet.	<p>Mineral Survey No. 4227 was made with a Buff and Buff Transit No. 7674, with a horizontal limb 6.0 ins. diam., having two double opposite verniers, and vertical arc 4.5 ins. diam., having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of arc. The instrument was in good condition at the time of the survey and all adjustments were in good order.</p> <p>A p.m. observation on Polaris for azimuth was made at the point of beginning, the details of which are shown in the calculation sheets herewith submitted for examination.</p> <p>All azimuths in this record are referred to the true meridian thus determined, by the method of deflection angles and calculated courses.</p> <p>The lines were measured with a Dietzgen steel tape 300 feet in length, graduated to feet and the end feet graduated to tenths and hundredths; which was compared with a standard steel tape at the time of beginning the survey, and found correct.</p> <p>All lines and connections of this survey were run by direct methods (where the lines are accessible, the lines were run by traverse methods, as shown by the calculation sheets herewith submitted).</p> <p>The magnetic variation observed at each corner of the survey gave a uniform value of $14^{\circ}45'E$.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">INFIDEL LODE.</p> <p>Beginning at Cor. 
