Precise Transit, light mountain model, with horizontal
limb 6.25 inches in diameter, having two double opposite
verniers, and full vertical circle 5 inches in diameter,
having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of are; the eye piece is equipped with a prismatic

The instrument was in good condition at the time of survey and all adjustments were in good order. All azimuths in this record are referred to the true meridian as determined for the primary triangulation system of the Warren Mining District and in use by the Phelps Dodge Corporation, Shattuck-Denn Mining Corporation and the Wolverine & Arizona Mining Company, by the method of deflection angles and calculated courses. The lines were measured with Keuffel & Esser Steel tape,

100 ft. in length, graduated to feet, tenths and hundredths of feet for the entire length; a Keuffel & Esser steel tape 300 feet in length, graduated to feet, tenths and hundredths of feet for entire length; a Lufkin steel tape, 25 feet in length graduated to feet inches and fractions of inches length, graduated to feet, inches and fractions of inches for the entire length. All tapes were compared with a Lufkin standard tape at the time of beginning the survey and found correct.

All lines and connections of this survey were run by direct methods.
