Mineral Survey No. 4287 was made with a C. L. Berger & Sons precise transit, with horizontal limb 6.25 inches in diameter, having double opposite verniers, and full vertical approaches to the control of the control o tical circle 5 inches in diameter, having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of arc; the eye piece is equipped with a colored glass slide in a prismatic eye piece for making direct observations upon the sun. The instrument was in good condition at the time of survey and all adjustments were in good order. An a. m. altitude observation of the sun for azimuth, and at noon on
the meridian for latitude, were made at Cor. No. 1 of the
White Lily lode, the details of which observations are
shown in the calculation sheets submitted herewith for All azimuths in this record are referred to examination. the true meridian thus determined, by the mthod of deflection angles and calculated courses.
