This survey was made with a Gurley transit No. 50962, with horizontal limb 6.25 ins. diam., having two double opposite verniers, and full vertical circle 5 ins. diam., having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of arc; the eyepiece is equipped with a colored glass set in the dust shutter for making direct observations upon the sun. . The instrument was in good condition at the time of the survey and all adjustments were in good order. All azimuths in this record were determined by the method of

deflection angles referred to the meridian determined by the follow-

ing observation:

- August 17, 1956, at cor. No. 4 of the Good-Hope placer in latitude 34°27'20"N., and longitude 112°22'40"W., I made a series of eight altitude. observations upon the sun for azimuth at approximately equal time intervals, four each with the telescope in direct and reversed positions observing the opposite limbs of the sun, and reading the horizontal angle from a reference point about 300 ft. southward to the sun. , biw . ..

Mean time of observation, 105th meridian standard time =9h9m40sa.m. Declination of sun at mean time of observation =13°17°30" N. Mean observed vertical angle to sun's center =39°41'50" Mean horizontal angle from reference point to. sun's center True bearing to reference point land to the N. 20°17'40" E. True bearing of line 4-1 Good Hope placer = N. 59 18 W.

The lines were measured with a Lufkin steel tape 300 ft. in length, graduated every foot, the first and last foot being graduated to tenths and hundredths. The tape was compared with a Lufkin standard tape at the time of beginning of the survey and found correct.

All lines and connections of this survey were run by direct methods.

The magnetic declination observed at each corner of the survey gave a uniform value of 14°30'E.
