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This survey was made with a Buff & Buff light mountain transit No. 8871, with horizontal circle 4.5 ins diam., having two double opposite verniers and full verticle circle 3 3/4 ins. diam., having one double vernier; the verniers reacting to one minute of arc; observations on the sun were made by holding a card upon which the sun's image with respect to the cross hairs was viewed. The instrument was in good condition at the time of the survey and all adjustments were in good order.

The tape was checked against a standard distance on the University of Arizona campus and found to

be .correct. All lines and connections of this survey were run by direct methods.

The magnetic declination observed at each corner of the survey gave a uniform value of 14°30' E.
