This survey was made with a Berger transit No. 17503, with horizontal limb 5 1/8 ins. diam., having two double opposite verniers and full vertical circle 5 ins. diam., having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of arc; a prismatic eyepiece with colored glass was attached to the eyepiece of the transit for making direct observations upon the sun. The instrument was in good condition at the time of the survey and all adjustments were in good order.

All azimuths in the record were determined by the method of deflection angles referred to the meridian, determined by direct observation on the sun:
