This survey was made with a K. & E. transit, No. 51591, with horizontal limb 5.5 ins. diam., having two double opposite verniers, and full vertical circle 4.5 ins. diam., having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of arc; the instrument is equipped with a colored-eye-shade to be attached for making direct observations on the sun. The instrument was in good condition at the time of the survey and all adjustments were in good order.

All azimuths in this record were determined by the method of horizontal-angles-right referred to the meridian established by direct observation on the sun. At 8:50 A.M. on August 11, 1961 at cor. No. 1 of the Turkey Track #1 Placer, latitude $33^{\circ}40'09''$ North, longitude, $112^{\circ}02'33''$ West, turning from a reference pt. about 660 ft. north, clockwise to the sun in a west direction.

True bearing of reference pt.

N. $0^{\circ}45'$ W.

The lines were measured with a Lufkin steel tape, 300 ft. in length graduated every ft. for 299 ft. and the remaining ft. graduated to tenths and hundredths. The tape was compared to a standard at the beginning of the survey and found to be correct. All lines and connections of this survey were run by direct methods.

The magnetic declination observed at each corner of the survey gave a uniform value of 14° East.

DESCRIPTIVE REPORT

In accordance with Revised Statutes, sec. 2331, (30 U.S.C., sec. 35), the following descriptive report on the Turkey Track #1 placer is made.

This location is at an elevation of about 1600 ft. Very little soil covers the rocks. Vegetation is the usual cacti of the southwest - cholla, sahuaro, pricy pear, and barrel - and some palo verde trees and greasewood.

There are no streams or other bodies of water on the claim.

A description of the workings may be found under "Expenditures" in the regular field notes.

Phoenix, Arizona, a major city is located approximately 15 miles in southerly direction. A paved road from Phoenix passes within one-half mile of the claim.

Adjacent to this placer claim are several lode locations. Sur. No. 3740, Santa Rosa lode, joins this claim on the southwest side.

Decomposed granite is readily quarried from the claim and is a continuing process.

Little development work is necessary except for the clearing of brush and cactus.

An unimproved dirt road provides egress from the quarry to the paved road.

There are no mines, salt licks, salt springs or mill sites on the claims.
