This survey was made with a W. & L. E. Gurley transit, No. 57289, equipped with horizontal limb $6\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., having two double opposite verneirs, and a full vertical circle 5 ins. diam., having one double vernier; the horizontal verniers read to 30 secs. of arc; the vertical vernier reads to one minute of arc. This instrument was used in all-purpose taping and alignment procedures where great distances were not involved. Distances greater than 500 feet were measured in many cases using electronic distance measuring equipment, i.e., the Hewlett-Packard Model 3800 Distance Meter, Ser. No. 0987 A 00472, having a range of 10,000 feet and an absolute accuracy of 0.01 feet plus the distance measured divided by 100,000 in the normal operating temperature range. In all instances wherein the distance meter was used, vertical angles were measured with a Kern theodolite, Model DKM 2 AE, Ser. No. 145997, with microscopic angle-reading capabilities enabling the instrument man to read angles, either horizontal or vertical, to 1 sec. of arc. All three of these instruments were in good condition at the time of the survey and all adjustments were in good order.

All azimuths in this record were determined by the method of deflection angles referred to the meridian determined by the following observation:

November 20, 1971, at Cor. No. 2 of the INSPIRATION MILL SITE NO. IL 182, in latitude 33° 22' 47" N., and longitude 110° 55' 40" W., I make a series of six altitude observations upon the sun for azimuth at approximately equal time intervals, three each with the theodolite telescope in direct and reversed positions, observing opposite limbs of the sun, and reading the horizontal angles from a reference point approximately 1200 feet southwesterly clockwise to the sun.

Mean time of observation, 105th meridian, standard time = 10:40 a.m.

Declination of sun at mean time of observation = 19° 39' 34" S.

Mean observed vertical angle to sun's center, corrected for refraction and parallax = 32° 45' 52"

Mean horizontal angle from
reference point to sun's center,
turned clockwise and to the
right to sun's center = 154° 33' 37"

True bearing to reference point = N. 0° 00' 53" E.

The lines were measured with either a Lufkin steel tape or with the aforementioned electronic distance meter. The tape was 500 feet in length, graduated every foot for 500 ft., with an added foot on the zero end graduated in tenths and hundredths; the tape was compared with a standard 100.00 foot tape at the time of the beginning of the survey and found to be correct, The distance meter was compared with a taped course, 1200 feet in length, measured as a base-line with a standard 100.00 tape, and found to be precise and accurate.

All line and connections of this survey were run by direct methods.

The magnetic declination observed at each corner of the survey gave a uniform value of 13° 30' E.

Note concerning monumentation: With the exception of those corners which were not monumented for reasons given in each case, or which were monumented as otherwise described herein, I have set iron posts at each corner of each mill site claim comprising this survey. Each iron post consists of a 3/4-inch nominal inside diam. galvanized water pipe having a 1 ins. exterior diam.; each pipe has been placed in the ground in a foundation consisting of not less than ½ cu. ft. of high early strength portland cement concrete mixed at the site. Brass caps have been securely attached and marked as described, using 1/8-in. steel dies for stamping. Alongside every corner monument I have erected a rock monument having a base two feet minimum diam., and a height of not less than two feet.

The INSPIRATION MILL SITE NO. The portion of this homestead (referred to herein as the Schulze Homestead) situate in sec. 2, T. 1 S., R. 14 E., G.&S.R.M., has been the subject of a cadastral survey by the B.L.M. in the year 1967, at which time some of the corners of the homestead were re-monumented but only in said sec. 2. However, I am in possession of the records of a survey of the Schulze Homestead made by Oscar T. Smith, Ariz. Land Surveyor Regis. No. 2648, and a U.S. Mineral Surveyor. Mr. Smith made this survey in 1948 while an employee of Kenneth W. Hammes, Ariz. Civil Engineer Regis. No. 1038, and made the survey plat which is on file in the Gila County Corthouse as Official Map No. 96, Gila County Records. Iron drill steel pins were set by Mr. Smith at several positions along the borders of the Homestead, although he did not set a monument at the SW. corner in sec. 3. The position of the true point for said SW. cor. was calculated from recorded survey data, using found drill steel monuments as direct evidence for the establishment of bearings for the southerly and westerly boundaries of the Homestead. The NW. corner is a drill steel projecting 1 ins. above ground with a mound of stones alongside. The direction for the bearing of the northerly boundary of that part of the Homestead situate in sec. 3 was determined by connecting said NW. corner with the S-S-N1/256 sec. cor. of sec. 2 and 3, mkd. by an

iron post with brass cap marked as described in the official record of the 1967 cadastral survey by the B.L.M. The westerly boundary of the Schulze Homestead in sec. 3 was found to bear N. 0° 08' 15" E., 986.08 ft. dist., instead of N. 0° 09' 10" E., 985.30 ft. dist., as recorded in the aforementioned Hammes survey plat. The northerly boundary of the Schulze Homestead in sec. 3 was found to bear S. 89° 32' 50" E., 996.96 ft. dist., instead of S. 89° 35' 20" E., no distance given, as recorded in said survey plat.

The line between the standard ½ sec. cor. of sec. 33 and the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 1 N., R. 14 E., bears N. 89° 51' 04" E., 2638.82 ft. dist., instead of EAST, 2640 ft., as approved, 1906 Resurvey.

The line between the standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34 and the standard ½ sec. cor. of sec. 34, T. 1 N., R. 14 E., bears N. 89° 54' 46" E., 2635.92 ft. dist., instead of EAST, 2640 ft., as approved, 1906 Resurvey.

The line between the standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34, and the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 1 N., R. 14 E., bears N. 0° 00' 53" E., 2635.57 ft. dist., instead of N. 0° 02' W., 2640 ft., as approved, 1923 Survey.

The closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, T. 1 S., R. 14 E., marked by a grooved and scribed stone as described in the official record, was found to be 2.75 ft. on the north side of the Gila and Salt River Base Line. The line connecting said closing cor. stone with the standard 4 sec. cor. of sec. 33, T. 1 N., R. 14 E., was found to bear S. 89° 42' 04" W., 1050.84 ft. dist., instead of WEST, 1052.7 ft. dist., as approved, 1906 subdivisional survey of T. 1 S., R. 14 E.

The line connecting the ½ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, T. 1 S., R. 14 E., with the scribed stone marking the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4 was found to bear N. 1° 34' 43" W., 2299.92 ft. dist., instead of N. 0° 02' W., 2372.04 ft. dist., as approved, 1906 subdivisional survey of T. 1 S., R. 14 E.

The closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, T. 1 S., R. 14 E., marked by an iron post with brass cap, 2½ ins. diam., mkd. as described in the record of the 1967 Dependent Resurvey of a portion of the South Boundary of T. 1 N., R. 14 E., was found to be 1.40 ft. on the north side of the Gila and Salt River Base Line. The line connecting said closing cor. brass cap with the standard ½ sec. cor. of sec. 34, T. 1 N., R. 14 E.,

was found to bear S. 89° 53' 52" W., 1059.90 ft. dist., instead of S. 89° 58' W., 1061.28 ft. dist., as approved, 1967 Dep. Resurvey.

The line connecting the S-S-N 1/256 sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, T. 1 S., R. 14 E., with the brass capped pipe marking the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, T. 1 S., R. 14 E., was found to bear N. 0° 37' 38" W., 2040.13 ft. dist., instead of N. 0° 42' W., 2040.72 ft. dist., as approved, 1967 Dep. Resurvey.
