	<p>This survey was made with a Lietz Precise Transit, No. 65718, with horizontal limb 5½ ins. diam., having two double opposite verniers reading to 20 seconds of arc, and full vertical circle 4½ ins. diam., having one double vernier reading to 1 minute of arc. The eyepiece has a removable colored glass for making direct observations upon the sun. The instrument was in good condition at the time of the survey and all adjustments were in good order.</p> <p>All azimuths in this record were referred to the meridian of the Phelps-Dodge Copper Basin Project triangulation-system, set out on a local plane grid, and which I checked by solar observations made on October 21, 1973, as described in my field notes in Min. Sur. No. 4756, and found to be correct. At cor. No. 1 of the SKV Mill Site No. 2 amended, the latitude is 34°26½' N.; the longitude is 112°38½' W.</p> <p>The lines were measured with a Hewlett-Packard distance-meter, and a Chicago steel tape, 300 feet in length, graduated every foot, with the end feet graduated to tenths; which was compared with a Lufkin standard at the time of beginning the survey and found correct.</p> <p>All lines and connections of this survey were run by direct methods.</p> <p>The magnetic declination observed at each corner of the survey gave a uniform value of 14°00' E.</p>


