The subdivisional lines in this township, outside of the lines herewith described were not run, owing to the extreme r-oughness of the country as well as to the fact that the further subdividing of this township was not necessary to properly include all the agricultural and grazing lands lying along or with in the Canon of the Blue River or to properly include the claim of any settler residing within the Canon.
