double verniers, placed opposite each other, reading to
single minutes of arc, which is also the least count of
the verniers of the latitude and declination arcs.

These instruments were examined and tested on true meridian at Phoenix, Arizona, and found to be correct.

They were also tested at various times on meridian established in sec. 16, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.; for notes, see Book "D." Also, on meridian established near artesian well at old Camp McDowell, in sec. 6, T. 3, N., R. 7 E.; for notes, see Book "A" - Exterior Lines.
