Survey commenced Sept. 3, 1913, and executed jointly by Jesse B. Wright and William H. Elliott, U.S. Surveyors, Wright using inst. No. 8145, and Elliott using inst. No. 8492, made by Young & Son's, with Smith patent solar attachments, minute description and field test of these instruments heretofore given in books D and E. Knowing from recent and repeated tests made on a true meridian established by observation of Polaris that the instruments are in correct adjustment, we proceed as follows: (Initials J. B. W. and W. H. E. designate lines as run

by Wright and Elliott, respectively. )
