## GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This township is rough and mountainous except in the north eastern portion, which is rolling mountainous. At the time of survey there was running water in Deluge wash and for the upper two miles of Crow canyon. There are a few scattering pinon pine and cedar in the south half and some scattering cotton—woods along Deluge wash and Crow canyon. There are some old silver workings and molybdenum indications along Deluge wash. There are no settlers. Scant growth of grass affords some pasturage for horses and cattle.
