GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This township is rough and rolling mountainous throughout and lies on the summit of the Hualpai mountains. Deluge wash heads in the south central part and its course is easterly. Crow canyon has its origin in the central part of the township and also drains easterly, both drainage systems have running water a part of the year. there is a spring in sec. 17 that supplies water to Esham's ranch in sec. 19. The soil is of poor quallity, stony and mostly 3rd. rate. The vegetation consists mostly of the various kinds of desert brush and cacti and there are scattering scrub pinon pine and juniper on the summit of the Hualpais. A wagon road and telephone line crosses the township from east to west between Copperville and Yucca, also a road and telephone line enters the township in sec. 36 and extends northwesterly and joins the road and telephone line to Yucca in sec. 19. Eshams ranch is located at the junction of the two roads in the NW. 1/4 of sec. 19. The only other settlers in the township are at Copperville, a small mining camp on the east boundary of sec. 13. There is a group of patented mining claims lying partly within the township at Copperville, in sec. 13, produceing gold, silver, copper, zinc and lead.
