Survey executed by Mans H.Coffin, Jr., U. S. Surveyor, and Howard G.Mason, U.S. Transitman, using transits Nos. 8540 and 8298, respectively, provided with Smith solar attachments. These instruments were examined at Phoenix, Arizona, on Nov. 6, 1915, by the Assistant Supervisor of Surveys for Arizona and California, and approved conditional upon satisfactory field tests. Before beginning the surveys described in the following notes, test of instrument No. 8540 was made by Mans H.Coffin, as follows:
