General Description.

This township is mountainous, the western part being high up on the eastern slope of the Hualpai mountains, and the eastern part lower, being deeply cut by many sand washes.

The soil is very rocky and unfit for cultivation. It supports a sufficient growth of bunch grass to afford pasture for several herds of goats and a considerable number of cattle. The western part of the township is covered with a dense growth of scrub oak, mahogany, catclaw, mesquite, juniper, and, on a few of the highest peaks, scattering

pinyon pines.
Water was found in se veral of the washes, but does not appear to be of permanent duration throughout the year.
Indications of iron, copper and tungsten were noted.
There are no settlers in the township.
