A description of the instruments used, with record of approval by the assistant supervisor of surveys, and field tests, appears in Book A.

The instruments were examined and placed in thorough adjustment at the beginning of work on this township, said adjustments being checked and maintained by comparison with a meridian determined by observation on Polaris at elongation.

The magnetic declination in this township is 16.00 E.

Preliminary to commencing the subdivision of this township. 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GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Sections 1 to 5 and 8 to 12, inclusive, consist of rolling land. The balance of the township consists of rugged mountains, with steep slopes, covered with loose rock and huge boulders. Drainage is to the east and northeast.

The soil is rocky; 4th rate in the mountains and 2nd am 3rd rate in the rolling portions. The mountains are covered with a dense growth of manzanita, buck-brush, scrub oak, catclaw, cactus, and, in sections 20, 21, 22, 27 and 28, piñon and cedar. The prairie land supports a scant growth of cactus, sage-brush, grass and various weeds.

The township contains several small springs, which have been developed for stock watering purposes by piping the water to troughs.
