The instruments used are described, with record of approval by the assistant supervisor of surveys for Arizona and California, and field tests, in Book E. The adjust-ments were maintained throughout the survey by frequent comparison of the results of sloar observations with true meridians determined by observations on Polaris.

The mean magnetic declination is 15° E.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The land in this Tp.is broken and mountainous. Drainage except for one tier of sections on the east being into Knight Creek, which is a stream of clear pure water, with its head insec. 14, and leaves the township on west bdy.of sec.18. Its average width is 20 lks., and depth 1 ft. A small stream heads in sec.13, and leaves Tp. on E. bdy. of sec.24. Water exists in several gulches near their heads, but sinks in the sand after running for a short distance.

The soil, is rocky and gravelly, and the land is non-agricultural. It supports a scant growth of grass, and a growth, varying from dense to thin of crucifixion thorn, cactus, palo verde, greasewood, oak brush and ocotillo. Cottonwood and willow grow along Knight Creek.
