- Surveys hereinafter described executed by Joseph P. Davis, U. S; Cadastral Engineer and Claude Marner, U.S. Transitman, on dates shown on diagram on page 1 hereof, using respectively Buff light mountain transit No. 10125 and Young and Sons light mountain transit No. 8532. For description of instruments and certificate of approval, see Book "A".
- Unless otherwise specified, all measurements are made with a Lufkin steel tape, 5 chs. in length, compared with a Chesterman standard steel tape and found correct. measurements are made on the slope, the vertical angles determined and the slope measurements properly reduced to true horizontal distances.
 - Examine the adjustments of the thansits and correct all errors; then, to test the solar apparatus, by comparing their indications, resulting from solar observations made during a.m. and p.m. hours, with a meridian determined by observations on Polaris at elongation, we proceed as follows:
- G. and S. R. B. and M., lat. 36°57'N., long. 113°36'W., at 3 hrs. 0 m., p.m., 1.m.t., we set off 36°57'N. on the lat. arcs; 6°32'N. on the decl. arcs, and determine April 6, 1921. a meridian with each solar, marking the line thus determined by a tack driven in a stake, 5 chs. N. of our sta tion.
- At 6 hrs. 29.1 m. p.m., l.m.t., we observe Polaris at western elongation, in accordance with the Manual of Instructions, and mark the line thus determined by a tack driven in a stake, firmly set in the ground, 5 chs. N. of our station.
- April 7, 1921. At 7 hrs. a.m., 1.m.t., se lay off the azi muth of Polaris, 1°24' to the east, and find that the true meridian thus determined agrees with the meridian determined by solar observations the afternoon before.
- At 9 hrs. 0 m., a.m., al.m.t., we set off 36°57'N. on the lat. arcs, 6°49'N. on the decl. arcs and determine a a.m., al.m.t., we set off 36°57'N. on the meridian with each solar, which agrees with the true meridian.
- As all of the solar observations during the usual hours of solar work come within 1'30" of the true meridian, conclude that the adjustments of the solars are satisfactory.

A high mesa in secs. 31,32, and 33, known as Mokiah Mountain is the highest point in the township.

The soil varies with the surface from rocky, 4th rate, to sandy, gravelly clay, 2nd rate. The undergrowth consists of black brush, shellac brush, sagebrush and yucca. There are no settlers. A spring is found in the NW. quarter of sec. 28, which is the only permanent running water in the Tp. There are no indications of mineral. Two roads bearing N. and S. traverse the township.
