- Surveys hereinafter described, executed on dates shown on diagram on page 1 hereof, by Quintin Campbell, U.S. Surveyor, and Kenneth W. Bond, U.S. Transitman, using respectively, Young and Sons light mountain transits Nos. 8491 and 8477. Each instrument is equipped with full vertical circle, and the Smith solar attachment. Unless otherwise specified, all azimuth determinations are accomplished with the solar attachments.
- April 25,1920. We examine the adjustments of each instrument, and correct all errors; then, to test the solar apparatus by comparing its indications from observations made during a.m. and p.m. hours, with a meridian established by Polaris observation, March 29, 1920, at camp in SE. 4 of sec. 36, T.27 N., R. 8 W., near the cor. of Ts. 27 and 28 N., Rs. 7 and 8 W., as described in Book "A," proceed with each instrument as follows:
- At 8h.00m., a.m., l.m.t., set off $35^{\circ}41^{\circ}$ on the lat.arc; $13^{\circ}14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}N$. on the decl.arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which agrees with the true meridian.
- At app, noon, with the lat.arc unchanged, observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting reading of the decliarc is 13°17½'N., which agrees with the computed decliof the sun.
- At 4h.00m. p.m., l.m.t., with the lat.arc unchanged, set off 13°21'N. on the decl.arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which agrees with the true meridian.
- As all of the solar observations made with both instruments during the usual hours of solar work come within 1' 30" of the true meridian, we conclude that the adjustments are satisfactory.

Unless otherwise specified, all measurements are made with Lallie steel tapes, 2 and 5 chs. in length, compared with a Lufkin standard steel tape, and found correct. The measurements are made on the slope, the vertical angle determined, and the slope measurements properly reduced to true horizontal distances.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This township lies entirely within the Hualpaid Indian Reservation, and the surface varies from level to mountainous. The narrow bottom of a valley bearing N. and S.

draining S.along the south half of the West boundary of the township, and forming the head of Aubrey Valley, contains nearly all of the level surface of the township.

A divide passes thru. the township in the two central ranges of sections, from which the land drains N. and Sw. To the Sw. of the divide, the surface is mountainous and rolling, and to the N. is rolling and hilly.

The soil over most of the township is gravelly and rocky, 4th rate. In the bottom of the valley in the southwestern part is a sandy and gravelly clay loam, 1st rate, and along the east side of the valley is a sandy and gravelly soil, 2nd and 3rd rate.

The timber consists of juniper and pine, and with the exception of part of the bottom of the valley, where there is either no timber or a very scattering growth,

there is a scattering or dense growth in all sections. The undergrowth consists of scrub oaklsage brush, prickly ash, manzanita, quinine brush and scrub juniper, and covers most of the surface in dense and scattering growths. Some small scattered tracts are bare of undergrowth.

There is good grass over the bottom of the valley, and fair grass in other scattered small areas, but the most of the township is devoid of grass.

There are no indications of valuable mineral deposits. There is a spring in section 6, and another in sec. 18. A reservoir for water storage is constructed in sec.

6, and another in sec. 35, known as "Hog Ranch Tank."
There are no settlers residing within the township. The improvements, aside from the reservoir mentioned, consist of a corral in sec. 18, a range fence thru. secs. 6, 7 and 18, a water pipe line thru. bottom of valley, a road bearing MW. and SM. thru. the $2.\frac{1}{2}$ of Tp., a road bearing N. and S., thru. bottom of valley, and a road bearing NJ. and

Sw. thru. the W. 2 of To.
"Fraziers' Well" at the Sanford Ranch is situated near the W. bdy. of sec. 19.
