

Surveys herein described were executed on dates shown on diagram on page 2 hereof, by Glenn F. Sawyer U.S. Surveyor and Charles E. Hunter, U.S. Transitman, using respectively, Young and Sons light mountain transit No. 8478 and Buff and Buff light mountain transit No. 10125, each equipped with full vertical circle and Smith solar attachment; unless otherwise specified, all azimuth determinations are accomplished with the solar attachment.

PRELIMINARY TEST OF YOUNG AND SON'S INSTRUMENT NO. 8478, BY GLENN F. SAWYER.

December 18, 1925: examine the adjustments of the transit and find them correct; then to test the solar apparatus, by comparing its indications, resulting from observations made during a.m. and p.m. hours with a meridian established by Polaris observation, proceed as follows:

December 19, 1925: At camp near the 4 sec. cor. of secs. 8 and 17, T4N,R7W., G. and S.R. Base and Meridian, Ariz, latitude 33,41,42"N., longitude 113,000 W., at lh 43m a.m., l.m.t., observe Polaris at western elongation, making four observations, two each with the telescope in direct and reversed positions, and mark the mean point in line thus determined on a peg driven firmly in the ground 5 chs. northerly.

Azimuth of Polaris at western elongation, 1°18'31"

At 7h 45m a.m., l.m.t., lay off the azimuth of Polaris, l°18½ to the east and mark the meridian thus determined by a tack in a peg driven firmly in the ground 5 chs north.

At 8h 0m a.m., l.m.t., set off $33^{\circ}4^{\frac{1}{2}}$ N. on the latarc, $23^{\circ}2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ S. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which is found to agree with the true meridian.

At apparent noon, with the lat. arc unchanged, observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting reading of the decl. arc is 23°24'S., which agrees with the computed decl. of the sun.

At 4h Om p.m., l.m.t., with the lat. arc unchanged, set off 23°22'S. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar, which is found to agree with the true meridian.

As all of the solar observations during the usual hours of solar work come within l' of the true meridian, conclude that the adjustments of the instrument are satisfactory.

PRELIMINARY TEST OF BUFF AND BUFF

INSTRUMENT NO. 10125, BY CHARLES E. HUNTER

December 21, 1925: examine the adjustments of the transit and correct all errors; then to test the solar apparatus, by comparing its indications, resulting from observations made during a.m. and p.m. hours with a meridian established by Polaris observation, proceed as follows:

This test was made on the meridian established on Dec. 19, by Glenn F. Sawyer, U. S. Surveyor, and hereinbefore described.

December 22, 1925: At 8h 0m a.m., l.m.t., set off 33°41½'N. on the lat. arc, 23°23'S. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which is found to agree within 1' with the true meridian.

At apparent noon, with the lat. arc unchanged, observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting reading of the decl. arc is 23°25'5., which agrees with the computed decl. of the sun.

At 4h 0m p.m., l.m.t., with the lat arc unchanged, set off 23°23'S. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar, which is found to agree with the true meridian.

As all of the solar observations during the usual hours of solar work come within l' of the true meridian, conclude that the adjustments of the instrument are satisfactory.

Unless otherwise specified, all measurements are made with Lufkin steel tapes, 5 chs. in length, compared with a Lufkin steel tape, 1 ch. in length, and found correct. The measurements are made on the slope, the vertical angle determined and the slope measurements properly reduced to true horizontal distances.
