

Surveys herein described were executed on dates shown on diagram on page 2 hereof, by Glenn F. Sawyer, U. S. Surveyor and Charles E. Hunter, U. S. Transitman, using respectively, Young and Sons light mountain transit No. 8478 and Buff and Buff light mountain transit No.10125, each equipped with full vertical and Smith solar attachment; unless otherwise specified, all azimuth determinations are accomplished with the solar attachment.

PRELIMINARY TEST OF YOUNG AND SON'S INSTRUMENT NO. 8478, BY GLENN F. SAWYER.

February 10, 1926: examine the adjustments of the transit and find them correct; then to test the solar apparatus, by comparing its indications, resulting from observations made during a.m. and p.m. hours with a meridian established by Polaris observation, proceed as follows:

At camp near the center of sec. 20, T17N,R10W., G. and S.R.Base and Meridian,Ariz, latitude, 34°50'21"N., longitude, 113°22'10"W., at 10h.10m p.m., l.m.t., observe Polaris at western elongation, making four observations, two each with the telescope in direct and reversed positions, and mark the mean point in line thus determined on a peg driven firmly in the ground 10 chs. north.

Azimuth of Polaris at western elongation, 1°19'34"

February 11, 1926: At 7h 30m a.m., l.m.t., lay off the azimuth of Polaris $1^{\circ}19^{\frac{1}{6}}$; to the east and mark the meridian thus determined by a tack in a peg driven firmly in the ground 10 chs. north.

At 8h 0m a.m., l.m.t., set off $34°50^{\frac{1}{2}}$ 'N. on the lat. arc, 14°05'S. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which is found to agree with the true meridian.

At 4h 0m p.m., l.m.t., with the lat. arc unchanged, set off 13°58½5. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar which is found to agree with the true meridian.

As all of the solar observations during the usual hours of solar work come within l' of the true meridian, conclude that the adjustments of the instrument are satisfactory.

PRELIMINARY TEST OF BUFF AND BUFF INSTRUMENT NO.10125, BY CHARLES E. HUNTER.

examine the adjustments of the transit and find them correct; then to test the solar apparatus, by comparing its indications, resulting from observations made during a.m. and p.m. hours with a meridian established by Polaris observation by Glenn F. Sawyer on Feb. 10, 1926, hereinbefore described, proceed as follows:

At 8h 0m a.m., l.m.t., set off $34^{\circ}50\frac{1}{2}$ 'N. on the lat. arc, 13°05'S. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which is found to agree within 1' with the true meridian.

At apparent noon, with the lat. are unchanged, sobserve the sun on the meridian; the resulting reading of the decl. arc is 13°03'S., which agrees with the computed decl. of the sun.

At 4h Om p.m., l.m.t., with the lat. arc unchanged, set off 13°00'S. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar which is found to agree with the true meridian.

As all of the solar observations during the usual hours of solar work come within l' of the true meridian, conclude that the adjustments of the instrument are satisfactory.

Unless otherwise specified, all measurements are made with Lufkin steel tapes, 5 chs. in length, compared with a Lufkin steel test tape, 1 ch. in length, and found correct. The measurements are made on the slope, the vertical angle determined and the slope measurements properly reduced to true horizontal distances.

FINAL TEST OF INSTRUMENTS 8478 and 10125. AT COMPLETION OF THIS GROUP.

February 27, 1926:
We examine the adjustments of the transits and find them correct; then to test the solar apparatus, by comparing their indications, resulting from observations made during a.m. and p.m. hours with a meridian established by Polaris observation by Glenn F. Sawyer on Feb. 10, 1926, described on page 3 hereof, we proceed as follows:

At 8 h Om a.m., l.m.t., We set off 34°50½'N. on the lat. arcs, 8°26'S. on the decl arcs, and determine meridians with the solars, which we find to agree within 1' with the true meridian.

At apparent noon, with the lat. arcs unchanged, We observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting reading of each decl. arc is 8°23'S., which agrees with the computed decl. of the sun.

At 4h Om p.m., l.m.t., with the lat arcs unchanged, We set off 8°18'S. on the decl. arcs and determine : meridians with the solars, which we find to agree within 12' with the true meridian.

As all of the solar observations during the usual hours of solar work come within $1\frac{1}{2}$, of the true meridian, We conclude that the adjustments of the instruments were maintained, throughout the survey of this township.
