Surveys executed on dates shown on diagram on page 1 here of by William H. Thorn, U. S. Cadastral Engineer, using a Buff light mountain transit No. 18000; and Otis O. Gould, U. S. Transitman, using Buff light mountain transit No. 9305. Each of these instruments is equipped with smith solar attachment and the horizontal limb of each is provided with two double verniers placed opposite to each other reading to single minutes of arc which is also the least count of the latitude and declination arcs.

#### PRELIMINARY FIELD TEST.

Examine the adjustments of the transits, and find them correct; then, to test the solar apparatus by comparing its indications resulting from observations made during a. m. and p. m. hours with a meridian established by Polaris observation on November 6, 1926, as described in Book "A", proceed as follows:

William H. Thorn, U. S. Cadastral Engineer,

December 12, 1926. At 9 h. 0 m., a. m., app. t., set in off 33° 262' N. on the lat. arc; 23° 02' s. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which agrees with the true meridian.

At 3 h. 0 m., p. m., app. t., with the lat. arc unchanged, set off 23° 03' S. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which agrees with the true meridian.

- December 19, 1926. At 9 h. 0 m., a. m., app. t., set off 33°-262 N. on the lat. arc; 23° 222 S. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which agrees with the true meridian.
- As all of the solar observations made during the usual hours of solar work come within 12 of the true meridian, conclude that the instruments are in satisfactory adjustment.
- Unless otherwise specified all measurements by W. H. Thorn, U. S. C. E., were made with a Lufkin steel tape, 5.00 chains in length and all measurements by Otis O. Gould, U. S. Transitman, were made with a Lallie steel tape, 5.00 chains in length. All tapes were compared with a Lufkin steel tape 1 chain in length and found correct.
- All measurements herein recorded are made upon the slope, the vertical angles determined with a clinometer and the slope measurement properly reduced to true horizontal distance for entry in the field notes.

- At 8 h. 0 m., a. m., app. t., set off 33° 26% N. on the lat. arc; 22° 55' S. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar, which agrees with the true meridian.
- At 4 h. 0° m., p. m., app. t., with the lat. arc. unchanged, set off 22° 53' S., on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar, which agrees with the true meridian.
- As all of the solar observations made during the usual hours of solar work come within 12 of the true meridian, conclude that the instrument has remained in satisfactory adjustment during this work.
- The continued satisfactory adjustment of the solar apparatus of Buff Transit No. 18000 used in the execution of the surveys described in the foregoing notes is indicated from field tests described in Books F, G, and I of this Group

#### GENERAL DESCRIPTIONK
