The resurveys and surveys herein described were executed by Benjamin J. Kinsey, U.S. Surveyor, using Buff transit No. 18,000. The instrument is equipped with the Smith solar attachment and otherwise conforms to the standard requirements of the General Land Office. The instrument was examined, tested, and approved by the District Cadastral Engineer of Arizona and California on April, 25, 1933, at Glendale, California, subject to satisfactory field tests.

All azimuth determinations are accomplished with the solar attachment, except the special observation upon Polaris for true meridian, upon which to test the solar apparatus.

All measurements are made with a Lallie steel tape, 5-chs. in length, compared with a Lufkin standard and found correct.

The measurements are made on the slope, the vertical angle determined, and the slope measurements properly reduced to true horizontal distances for entry in the field notes.

PRELIMINARY FIELD TEST
-ofBuff transit No. 18,000
-byBenjamin J. Kinsey, U.S. Surveyor.

January, 9, 1934, at my station in center of section 22, T.7 N., R.3 W., G. & S.R. B. and H., Arizona, in latitude 33°56'N., and longitude 112°335'W., examine the adjustments of the transit and find no errors; then to test the workings of the solar apparatus, proceed as follows:

January, 10: at same station as above described;

At 9h.00m., a.m., app.t., set off 33°56'N., on lat. arc, 21°58'S., on decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar which I mark with a nail set in top of a peg, driven firmly in the ground about 5 chs. N.

At app. noon, with lat. arc unchanged, observe the sun on the meridian; the resultant reading of the declination arc is 21°57'S., which agrees with the computed declination of the sun.

At 3h.00m., app. t., with lat. arc unchanged, set off 21°55'S., on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar which agrees with the true meridian.

All of the observations taken agree within 1' conclude that the instrument is in a satisfactory state of adjustment.

January, 11: at same station as above described, observe Polaris at western elongation, making four observations, two each with the telescope in direct and reversed position, and marking the mean point in the line thus determined with a nail set in top of a peg, driven firmly in the ground about 5 chs. North.

Azimuth of Polaris at western elongation: 1°151.

Daylight; lay off the azimuth of Polaris 1°15% to the east, and mark the true meridian thus determined with a tack, set in top of a stake about 5 chs. North.

Comparision of the solar meridian with that determined by Polaris observation, indicates agreement within 1, therefore conclude that the instrument is in a satisfactory state of adjustment.

#### OBSERVATION FOR LATITUDE and TIME.

January, 11: at same station as above described, in approximate latitude 33°56'N., I make a meridian observation of the sun for time and latitude, observing simultaneously, the altitude of the suns lower limb, and the transit of the the suns west limb, reversing the telescope and observing simultaneously the altitude of the suns upper limb, and the transit of the suns east limb.

The south four miles of this township boundary were surveyed in 1872 by S.W.Foreman, U.S.D.S., who established corners thereon with common reference to areas on both sides of the line, at 40 ch. intervals counting from the south. This portion of the line was retraced by Roy J. Gill, U.S.S. in 1916, who reported all corners missing. No subsequent retracement or resurvey of any part of this line is of record. There is no record of a survey of the North two miles of this township boundary.

The following notes describe a resurvey of the south four miles of the line, reestablishing corners with their original common reference, and a survey of the north two miles, establishing corners at 40 ch. intervals counting from the south, marked and witnessed to refer to areas E. of line only.

#### RETRACEMENT FOR RESURVEY

Retrace North, for 320,00 chs., making diligent search at intervals of 40 chs. and find no trace of any old corners thus agreeing with the record of the 1916 retracement of this line.



The principal washes being San Domingo and Trilby, which
carry intermittent streams of water. The elevation
above sea level ranges from 2700 ft. in the northeastern
corner to 700 ft. along the South Bdy. Living water
was noted at Tub Springs in section 17; Cottonwood
Springs in section 13; wells are located in secs. 10,
15, 21 and 22.

A settler lives in section 20, another in section 24, while many others following placer mining temporarily make their homes throughout the township.

The timber is scattering and consists of palo verde, mesquite, ironwood and scattering cottonwoods along the larger washes.

The undergrowth consists of various forms of cacti life, including sahuaros, catclaw, ocotillo and other brushes chiefly greasewood.

The main road from Morristown to Castle Hot Springs, crosses the Southeastern part of the township. The old highway from Hot Springs Junction to Wickenburg crosses the southwestern part of the township.

No active mining is being carried on at this time, in the township. The lands, generally are suitable for grazing.

For continued satisfactory adjustment of the instruments see preliminary field test in field notes of survey of T. 14 N., R. 5 W., executed under this group.
