CHAINS

The purpose of this survey is to subdivide the north half of the section into legal subdivisions and fractional lots that will accommodate two farm units to be used in connection with the development of land in the Yuma Mesa Division of the Gila Project, Arizona.

Township 9 South, Range 23 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona, survey was completed in March 1874 and the township plat was approved in May 1874. There has been no subsequent supplemental survey of Section 1 executed since the original survey of 1874. There are records in the Yuma Project files to the effect that in September of 1912 Kenneth Sawyer, Engineer, Bureau of Reclamation, found the original corners or evidence of the corners. To perpetuate the corners in the original position he replaced the deteriorated mesquite posts with 4" x 4" redwood posts properly scribed. Subsequent replacement of deteriorated redwood posts, either by new 4" x 4" redwood posts or by brass caps, was done to further perpetuate the original location of the corners.

All corner monuments were found in place and are as described in the following notes.

This survey was executed with a Keuffel & Esser transit, serial number 92796, which is provided with double verniers reading to 30 seconds of arc. The instrument was examined and tested and found to be in good condition and adjustment.

Lines between established corners are on true bearings adjusted to balanced sections and coordinates. In all cases the lines are run as the true lines except the line between the $SW_2^1NE_2^1$ and the $SE_2^1NW_2^1$ where it was necessary to run on an off-set line to avoid a line of power poles.

Original lot 1 is now divided into Lots 5, 6, and 7.
